## PROGRAM DATES & TIMES

The Junior Program is offered to members exclusively. This 8-week program is scheduled for eight consecutive Tuesday evenings beginning May 10th. The lesson times will be 5:30, 6:30 and 7:30 and will be grouped by age, with younger Juniors starting in the earlier time slots.

We will be covering all aspects of the game, including safety and etiquette.

## OPERATION 36® (OP 36)

We are excited to be a newly licensed Operation 36® facility! Every golf program should be centered around playing golf and making it fun to track progress over time. We can now leverage the Op 36 development model and technology to make it fun for our golfers to improve their skills.

The Op 36 model will allow opportunity to make and monitor progress on the course

The Op 36 App will assist coaches to communicate with you about your Junior's progress, help set goals, and provide you with tools to guide your Junior outside of class

## SUNDAY FUNDAY

"Fundays" will be scheduled every Sunday afternoon beginning May 15th. Tee times will begin at 5pm and may be adjusted throughout the season for daylight and/or participation.

We are excited for our juniors to play more golf. This "Funday" is an opportunity for families, and/or a few friends, to enjoy 9 holes of golf on a regular basis. This is also an opportunity for our Junior golfers to practice, progress and challenge the Op 36 divisions.

On-course parental supervision is required for Juniors 9, or under. Regardless of age, a parent will be required to keep score should their child be using the round as an official Op36 assessment round.

## 2022 JUNIOR CODE OF CONDUCT & RULES

Mickelson National Golf Club takes pride in all of its members and facilities. Golf is a game of respect and honour for yourself, your competitors, and the golf course. The Code of Conduct below identifies the basic standards we require from our Junior golfers at Mickelson National Golf Club.



## DRESS CODE

Proper golf attire is required while using the golf facilities. This includes:

- Clothing worn in a neat and respectable manner
- Collared shirts for boys and golf tops or dresses for girls
- Tailored golf pants, capri pants, golf shorts or skorts for girls
- Boys shirts should be tucked in
- Jeans, sweatpants, short shorts, tank tops, or sleeveless shirts (boys) are not permitted
- Hats to be worn forward at all times

## GOLF COURSE & CLUBHOUSE BEHAVIOUR

Respect of staff and other patrons is mandatory behaviour. Abusive or inappropriate conduct or language, including temperamental outbursts or abuse of the golf course, its patrons or its facilities, is unacceptable and will not be tolerated.

## VIOLATIONS OF THE CODE OF CONDUCT

If a minor violation occurs, the individual will be prohibited from further participation until he/she complies with the above code. The individual must do so without delay and maintain the standard. Any actions considered serious may result in the individual being removed or excluded from any Junior Programs or activities until the incident is reviewed by the Professional Staff.
